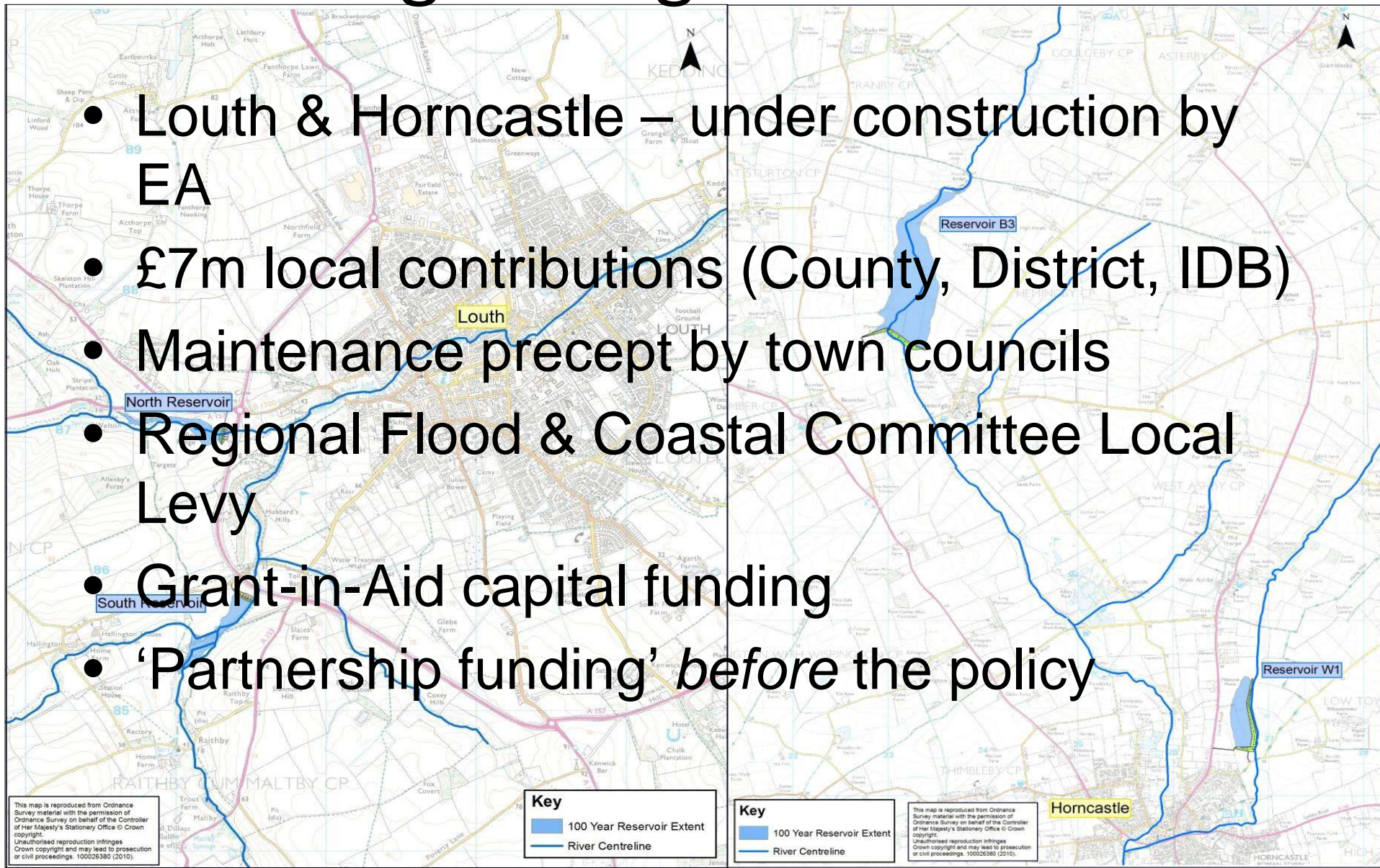

# Funding Package for fluvial risk

- Louth & Horncastle – under construction by EA
- £7m local contributions (County, District, IDB)
- Maintenance precept by town councils
- Regional Flood & Coastal Committee Local Levy
- Grant-in-Aid capital funding
- ‘Partnership funding’ *before* the policy





# Delegation of Powers

- IDB 'extended' areas
- LLFA consenting & enforcement powers for whole county
- Memorandum of Agreement for three years
- Consistent approach
- Accountable



# Project Development & Delivery

- Coastal flooding in December 2013
- Wash Frontagers Group
- Private sea bank (Jubilee Bank) at Friskney
- Repaired by local landowners
- Creates conditions to go further...





# New projects

- 5km section of EA seabank south of Jubilee Bank
- IDB leads project, procuring contractors locally
- Some Grant-in-Aid available – managed by EA
- Frontagers provide land for enlarged footprint
- Local Enterprise Partnership opens up additional funding streams
