WHAT IS THE ASSOCIATION OF DRAINAGE AUTHORITIES?

The **Association of Drainage Authorities (ADA)** is the association for water level management organisations in the United Kingdom, with **over 230 members**.

ADA was **established in 1937** to watch over and support the interests of drainage authorities at a national and parliamentary level, provide a forum for the exchange of ideas and discussions, and disseminate information of common interest.

ADA is recognised as the national representative of the Internal Drainage Boards (IDBs) in England and Wales. (IDBs are local public bodies established in areas of special drainage need in England and Wales to undertake works to manage flood risk and water levels on behalf of their community.)

Offers support with technical and administrative problems

Publishes the ada gazette four times a year

Organises national conferences, technical workshops and visits

Responds to, and works with Government and its agencies

Provides a link to sister organisations in Europe via the European Union of Water Management Associations (EUWMA)

Produces and collaborates with industry reports, bulletins, guidance, consultations and responses
