Description GIS and Environmental Technician

Following an internal restructure an exciting vacancy has developed for a GIS and Environmental Technician, working for Black Sluice Internal Drainage Board in Southern Lincolnshire.

The GIS and Environmental Technician will be the responsible lead for managing, maintaining and developing the GIS systems along with all environmental projects and schemes.

Based at the Boards head office at Swineshead and working in a small team within the key areas of responsibility identified on the job specification sheet.

We are looking for a highly motivated person with the knowledge, skills, experience and personal qualities necessary to manage, maintain and develop databases and spatial information whilst developing and progressing their role within environmental schemes and projects and conducting habitat surveys. You will have skills in analysing data using GIS and some knowledge of working with environmental enhancement projects.

You will manage and develop datasets, used together with environmental records to inform decision making and produce a range of products and services for public, private and third sector partners. Taking ownership and having a high regard for the integrity of data throughout our systems and processes, you will be able to demonstrate a personal commitment to biodiversity conservation and will thrive on the challenges offered through working for our organisation. It is a requirement that the successful candidate must have the right to work in the UK by the start of their employment.

Our primary role is to provide a front-line drainage and flood protection service within the greater Lincolnshire community. We protect land, critical infrastructure, commercial and residential property from flooding and ensure good land drainage. Much of this work involves the maintenance and improvements of watercourses and related infrastructure. Our Board supervise all matters relating to water level management within our catchment whilst supporting and promoting sustainability, the environment, agriculture, industry and commercial assets.
