1. Apologies

2. To confirm the Minutes of the Meeting held on 18 February 2016

4. ADA Welland and Nene Branch Joint Meetings with ADA Lincolnshire Branch

It was therefore agreed to continue to hold a separate ADA

5. Any Other Business

5.1 Planning

There was a general consensus from the majority of IDB Officers that IDBs do not have sufficient staffing resources to become statutory consultees in the Local Authorities planning process. Most felt that the current system of IDB/Local Authority Planning liaison worked well enough although it was acknowledged that the success of this very much depended on individuals in post today, which may change in the future.

5.2 Environment Agency

North Level IDB expressed an interest in purchasing the Environment Agency's dragline and they would be following this up with the Environment Agency in due course.

Environment Agency representatives gave an update on the de-maining of main river sections that are designated low/medium consequence.

5.3 Public Sector Cooperation Agreements (PSCAs)

Mr P Sharman asked that PSCAs with the Environment Agency should be extended for a longer period than the current 1 year arrangement and that it would be beneficial if all Environment Agency staff were 'on the same page' in terms of using PSCAs. It was suggested also that PSCA work should be promoted via ADA work streams and it was agreed that Mr H Cator would discuss this with the ADA Chief Executive.
