3. To confirm the Minutes of the Meeting held on 15 February 2017

The Minutes of the last Meeting, copies of which had been circulated, were approved and signed by the Chairman as a true record.

4. Matters arising from the Minutes

There were no matters arising.

5. Report from the Environment Agency

Ben Thornely, Flood Risk Manager for the Welland and Nene catchment provided a general update on EA matters:

- PSCA between EA and North Level IDB was working well. North Level IDB had purchased the EA's dragline for ongoing dredging works.
- EA management of badger setts EA was working with NE to close badger setts
 on sea banks and building artificial setts in locations not affecting the sea
 defences. P Sharman asked B Thornely for guidance/regulation on the removal
 of live badger setts and replacement with artificial setts.
- Consultation had closed on 12 February 2018 and EA was now assessing this
 feedback in respect of the de-maining pilot that included de-maining of tributaries
 of the South Forty Foot Drain and five watercourses in the Black Sluice IDB
 catchment. Responses received were positive although the actual response rate
 had been low.
- The capital programme was currently on target to deliver flood protection to some 3,800 properties by the end of 2017/18, of which 546 properties were within the Welland and Deepings IDB district. £3m in efficiencies had been achieved in the current capital programme and IDBs were encouraged to deliver further efficiencies. There was discussion around the time taken to consider Business Cases for FDGiA and the lack of IDB capital projects being taken forward. B Thornely acknowledged that this had not worked as well as EA had anticipated. The RFCC approved 50% Local Levy funded post to provide IDBs with assistance in FDGiA applications for capital projects would hopefully help to resolve the issue.

6. Water Transfer Licencing with effect from 1 January 2018

P Sharman had written to the EA querying the proposed licencing charges that would extend to IDBs. I Moodie reported that the new Water Transfer Licencing regulations were a major concern to ADA, who did not understand the inclusion of IDBs within these regulations. ADA was continuing to liaise with Defra/EA for either a change in the regulations or exemption for IDBs.

7. Any Other Business

7.1 ADA Branch Meetings

There was discussion on the merits of retaining a separate ADA Welland and Nene Branch meeting given the joint meeting of the ADA Lincs / Welland and Nene Branches but there was no clear decision to cease the separate meeting and at least one member IDB wanted to continue to meet both separately and jointly. Any changes to meetings may also require changes to the Branch Constitution.

7.2 Presentation to Mr J H R Hoyles MBE

The Chairman presented Mr John Hoyles, North Level IDB with a Sheaffer pen to mark the occasion of Mr Hoyles' retirement from the ADA Welland and Nene Branch. Mr Hoyles had attended the inaugural meeting of this Branch in 1986 and his attendance today marked his fiftieth meeting.
